GENERAL INFORMATION

Frequency: Please visit HarmonyOutreach.org for specific dates.

Passport: Need current passport with copy provided to Harmony offices.

Attire: Cambodian society frowns on women exposing shoulders or knees. Dress comfortably for hot, humid weather, but please keep these guidelines in mind.

Immunizations: We do not require immunizations. Please consult the CDC website (www.cdc.gov/travel) or your doctor for recommendations.

Medical Insurance: Harmony will provide travel medical insurance for all trip participants.

Physical Considerations: Cambodia is a hot and humid, developing country. The trip can be physically taxing. Those who are pregnant, physically challenged, elderly, or overweight should consider carefully whether to go. Healthy children 10 and over are invited to accompany parents.

Attitude: You will be doing ministry in a developing country. Cambodia is very different from the U.S. Be flexible with an attitude to serve. This is not intended as a luxury vacation. Roads can be rough and local ground transportation will be mostly by tuk tuk—a motorized rickshaw.

Trip Cost



Day 1
Cultural orientation.
Travel by tuk tuk to site of Killing Fields and S-21 Torture Prison. Ministry orientation.



Day 2
Phnom Penh Orphan Day! Includes picnic lunch, cultural dances by orphans and other fun activities.



Day 3
Outing with orphans to Water Park. Team dinner on River Street with government official.



Day 4
Bus trip through Cambodian countryside to Battambang. Dinner with Cambodian pastor.



Day 5
Our team will conduct services for a village church. Afternoon ministry outreach to villagers.



Day 6
Join village Christians for traditional lunch at local landmark. Evening bus ride to Siem Reap.



Day 7
Team devotions poolside. Travel by tuk tuk to explore the three sites of historic Angkor Wat. Evening cultural dinner and dance show.



Day 8
Tour, shop and dine on famous Pub Street. Afternoon flight back to Phnom Penh.

Free day. Shop at Russian Market or tour Royal Palace. Late night flight home.
