## GENERAL INFORMATION

**Passport:** Valid Passport with expiration date at least 90 days AFTER you return.

**Visa:** As a Communist country, Vietnam requires a visa prior to travel. We recommend you use a service. Call us to get our visa service contact information. The process should be started 60 days prior to travel as it takes time to arrange your visa.

**Immunizations:** We do not require immunizations. Please consult the CDC website ([www.cdc.gov/travel](http://www.cdc.gov/travel)) or your doctor for recommendations.


**Medical Insurance:** Harmony provides travel medical insurance. Evidence of coverage will be emailed to you prior to travel.

**Attire:** Dress comfortably for warm, humid or rainy weather in modest attire that does not attract undue attention. No expensive jewelry.

### Physical Considerations:

Any excursion overseas can be taxing as there is often a considerable amount of walking. Those who are pregnant, physically challenged, elderly or overweight should consider carefully whether to go. Healthy children 10 and over are invited to accompany parents but are subject to specific approval.

**Attitude:** You will be doing ministry in a developing country. Vietnam is not like the U.S. Be flexible with an attitude to serve.

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# Sample Itinerary

# Trip Cost



## Day 1 (Mon)

Depart U.S. for flights to Vietnam

## Day 2 (Tues)

Arrive Hanoi late evening. 45-minute drive to historic district and check into hotel.



## Day 3 (Wed)

Cultural orientation. Half-day city tour to include lunch. Evening dinner with underground church leaders.

## Day 4 (Thu)

Drive to countryside for fellowship and lunch with Underground Church (UC) #1, including ministry at UC orphanage. Free evening in historic Old Quarter (dinner, Night Market, massage, etc.)



## Day 5 (Fri)

Drive to countryside for fellowship and lunch with UC #2, including ministry at UC drug-rehab center. Free evening and dinner in historic Old Quarter near beautiful Hoan Kiem Lake.



## Day 6 (Sat)

Drive to countryside for fellowship, lunch and worship with village families. Outreach possibly showing JESUS film. Free evening and dinner in historic Old Quarter.



## Day 7 (Sun)

Sunday worship with headquarters Hanoi UC. Lunch and fellowship with church members. Free evening and dinner in historic Old Quarter.



## Day 8 (Mon)

Drive to countryside for fellowship and lunch with UC #3. Worship and prayer following lunch. Free evening in historic Old Quarter.



## Day 9 (Tue)

4-hour ride to famous Ha Long Bay. Board ship for a 2-day cruise. Explore Soi Sim Island, swim, sun and kayak. 8-course Imperial Feast dinner aboard ship.



## Day 10 (Wed)

Explore Sung Sot Cave, take optional cooking class or laze on deck until your traditional Vietnamese family lunch is served. Afternoon return to Hanoi.



## Day 11 (Thu)

Free day! Sleep in, walk around beautiful Hoan Kiem Lake, shop, enjoy a last massage, etc. Late evening flights home.
